## TERM 2

### Term dates.

This is a ten (10) week term which commences on Monday 19 April and ends on Monday 28 June 2010 (a normal school day for primary and high school students). The July holidays are for three weeks with term three starting on Monday 19 July 2010.

### Public holidays

PLEASE NOTE: Jan and Eleanor are both having university degrees conferred on them on Monday 19 April 2010 and cannot teach on that day (but Ryan will be teaching his brass students as normal).

ALSO, this term has TWO public holidays in it:

- One for ANZAC day on 26 April.
- One for the Queen's Birthday on Monday 14 June.

**As a result of the above, all private pupils who have lessons on a Monday have only been billed for 9 weeks of private lessons as detailed below.**

**Monday 19 April** - Ryan is teaching his brass students as normal. Jan and Eleanor will not be teaching any lessons on this day and woodwind and piano students have not been charged for this missed lesson.

**Monday 28 April** - ANZAC day holiday. There are no lessons on this day, but Jan and Eleanor will make up their lessons during the term (see Jan or Eleanor to arrange an alternative lesson time). Ryan has no time when he can make up these lessons, so brass students have not been charged for this lesson.

**Monday 14 June** - Queen's Birthday holiday. All lessons on this day will be made up on the last day of term on Monday 28 June 2010.

**The Monday Kid's Music Class will not be held on any of the above three Mondays and their parents have only been billed for a 7 week term.**
